Naomi Horsfall - Young Townsperson

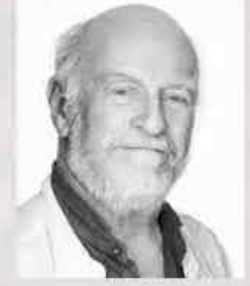

Paddy O'Keeffe - Marshal

Diana Banham - Tour Manager

This is the second time that Diana has been directed by the talented Mr Eaton, having played an equally distasteful character in David's inaugural production at the NVT, in the 10 Minute Plays Festival in 2015. Recent performances include the role of Tupolski in Martin McDonagh's 'The Pillowman' at The Marlborough and Quince, leader of the mechanicals, in Shakespeare's 'A Midsummer Nights Dream' at Stanmer House last summer.
